ManualsLib is an online library of almost two-million appliance manuals. This document will walk you through the process of locating and using the manuals on the site.



Although registration is encouraged, it is not required to view or download manuals. However, it is required if you want to upload a manual to share.

Locating Manuals

There are two ways you can locate manuals. If you know the brand and model number of the appliance you need the manual for, you can enter that brand and model number in the search box. Then click "search."



You can also scroll down the page above, and select a brand from the list. If you don't see the brand you're looking for, click the "A-Z" button to view the complete list.



An alphabetical list of all brands will then display. Jump through the list by clicking on the numbers or letters in the index at the top of the page.

Clicking on a brand in the left column will take you to the page for that brand.

Or, click on one of the brand categories, to be taken to the category subdivision for that brand. For example, Asus is further divided into pages for laptops, monitors, amplifiers, cell-phones, tvs, etc. Click the category that matches your

appliance. If you don't see a category for your appliance, try the over-all brand page.
